



Question: In your opinion, what was the instructor's greatest strength?

- Charismatic, always kept class engaging

Question: Do you have any suggestions for how the course might be improved?

- Could change the variety of topics to make some more engaging.
- Course focuses on articles during class time that do not benefit students when assigned lots of speeches and papers to write in short times.
- I think that because speeches took up so many days of class it always felt like the next assignment was right around the corner. With that said, there was plenty of time to complete assignments.

- The speech portion of the course is less interesting than the lectures and discussions on ethics. Lots of time is spent in class organizing and modifying directions and timelines for assignments and speech, and it felt like it woulld have been better spent on philosophy.
